On behalf of the Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix (DBIGP), I would like to offer you and your fellow Detroit Triumph Sportscar Club members the opportunity to volunteer for the 2008 race. This world-class sporting event, featuring Free Prix Day presented by Comerica Bank, the Detroit Sports Car Challenge presented by Bosch and the Detroit Indy Grand Prix presented by Firestone, will directly benefit our community. Proceeds from the event are designated for improvements to the facilities at Belle Isle. The success of this event, promoted by the Downtown Detroit Partnership, will depend heavily on the support of hundreds of volunteers who will assist in the production of the race weekend.
