Several DTSC members will be making a two-day drive down to historic Charleston, SC for this event, plus a little golf and/or sightseeing. On board so far are Mike Bilyk, Dan Campana, Dave & Laurie Carlson, and Dave & Sue Snyder.

We will be departing from our usual starting point at the 8 Mile and Haggerty Meijer parking lot at 7:00 am on Tuesday, October 20th, for the first 600 mile leg of our trip. We will stop over in Jonesville, NC and then continue on for another 280 miles to Charleston, arriving at our Patriot's Point hotel early afternoon on Wednesday. On Thursday and Friday, we plan to do some sightseeing (the boys are playing golf!) and visit historic Peninsula Charleston and the Naval Museum at Patriot's Point. The car show will take place on Saturday, October 24, and should keep us occupied for the entire day. As of now, there is no provision for early registration.

We will depart Patriot's Point Sunday morning for the first 560 mile leg of our return trip, stopping over in Marietta, OH. On Monday, October 26, we will complete the trip with a 320 mile drive back to the Detroit Metro area.

There are many points of interest in the Charleston area, and something to appeal to every taste. We are purposely leaving an open itinerary for Thursday and Friday, so you may select an activity which most interests you. Aside from the old city section of Charleston and the Naval & Maritime Museum at Patriot's Point, we will be in time for the last days of the 33rd Annual Fall Tours of Homes and Gardens. Charleston boasts over a dozen museums and many, many historic sights, including Ft. Sumter and numerous plantations. You can find information regarding all these at www.charlestoncvb.com.
